Overview

This application is for non-international undergraduate students who are ineligible to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the Department of Education. This form will provide the Office of Financial Aid a more accurate and detailed description of your current financial situation. This process allows for the office to review students in financial hardship for additional need-based institutional aid.

A Financial Aid Officer will email you to confirm receipt of this document. Additional information may be necessary, please check your IIT hawk email regularly. Once documentation is submitted, this review can take up to two weeks.

Along with this form, students should submit the following documents:

1. A detailed letter explaining financial hardship
2. Signed and dated student tax return (if available)
3. Signed and dated parent(s)' tax return (if available)
